**JOINT STATUS REPORT
AND JOINT MOTION TO RESET STATUS CONFERENCE**

1. The parties hereby submit the within Joint Status Report and Joint Motion to Reset Status Conference to the Court. Counsel for the plaintiffs has authority to submit the Status Report on behalf of all other parties to the case.
2. At the last Status Conference in this matter, the Court ordered that the parties file a Joint Status Report with the Court on or before March 6, 2009. Further, that a Status Conference take place on March 13, 2009 at 4:00 p.m.
3. The plaintiffs filed an Unopposed Motion for Additional Time to File Amended Complaint on February 20, 2009. The Court granted the motion on February 26, 2009 and extended the plaintiffs' deadline to file an amended complaint to March 16, 2009. The defendants will have ten days after the amended complaint is filed within which to file answers to the amended complaint. In the Order granting the plaintiffs' motion, the Court also advised the parties that a Status Conference could not be held at 4:00 p.m. on March 13, 2009 but had to be rescheduled to 1:30 p.m. on March 13, 2009 or reset to a later date.
4. The IEC has issued several Position Statements and Advisory Opinions, all of which have been filed with the Court. The IEC has not yet issued separate advisory opinions or letter rulings on the requests that the plaintiffs submitted to the IEC. The parties have not engaged in any discovery or filed any substantive motions since the last Status Conference with the Court.

5. The primary reason for resetting the Status Conference is to allow the IEC additional time to work on and respond to the plaintiffs' requests for advisory opinions and letter rulings. It would also be in the Court's and the parties' best interests to have a Status Conference after the plaintiffs have filed their amended complaint on March 16, 2009 and the defendants have answered the same.
6. The parties are in agreement that the Status Conference should be reset to a date no earlier than March 27, 2009.

WHEREFORE, the parties hereby submit, through counsel for the plaintiffs, the above Joint Status Report and respectfully request that the Status Conference be reset to a date no earlier than Friday, March 27, 2009.
